Every morning at 3, they pick the corn and sort through the cobs to get rid of any corn they themselves would not eat. Then, the corn is delivered straight from the farm to their sweet corn stands located in and around Wichita, Kansas. This direct market allows customers to experience sweet corn fresh picked daily and full of natural sweetness. Gaeddert Farms confidently stands behind their statement, "Freshest Corn in Kansas!"
